It is resolved that Ambassador Appointment policy is adopted as follows

Country and City Ambassador, Envoy, Campus Ambassador Appointment policy

Ambassadors for Education Charter are leaders in all walks of life, dedicated to building a worldwide community of service to support higher education, being an initiative of CCLP worldwide, to build a society of educated youth worldwide. Ambassadors are appointed to represent and lead the Education Charter International in their respective campuses, cities, countries and specialized assignment.

Ambassadors promoting Education Charter International are part of a global network of leaders representing the religious, racial and ethnic diversity of the human family, as well as all disciplines of human endeavor. They stand on the common ground of shared principles and are committed to the path of promoting, overcoming barriers, and building a just society conducive for Higher Education for the benefit of every youth worldwide.

The objective of appointing Ambassadors to promote the Education Charter International, with various ranks, is for the movement to avail itself of the competence, dedication and experience of individuals of recognized integrity from diverse geographical, cultural and professional backgrounds, who acknowledge the Charter of CCLP Worldwide and are committed to the active promotion and realization of its goals.

An individual may apply for ambassadorship by submitting following documents:

Self application (given format) in writing by email or post or by person or online filling duly addressed to Chairman or Secretary General of World Council

Details about social involvement and reasons for application (brief reply)

Self attested submission of Identity proof by email or by post

Submission of duly signed and witnessed license agreement by email or post

Recommendation by world council member or CCLP Worldwide member or regd. NGO

Agreement to place his or her communication address, photo and telephone in public domain i.e. the information about the successful applicant may be published at the site.

The submission of scanned copies of claimed certificates for verification, for applicants for the Country, City and Special Envoy positions,

All application should be addressed to Chairman of World Council,

In this context:

Once the secretariat receives the application for ambassadorship the same is forwarded to Chairman for preliminary acceptance or rejection.

Upon acceptance by Chairman, the applicants are intimated of the same and is asked for necessary compliance in terms of documents detailed above together with brief reply about his reason for joining the organization

Receipt of all the documents by Secretariat is intimated to chairman and Chairman initiates to propose the application before the member of world council for approval or rejection. The approval or rejection of same is done with majority votes

Accepted proposal becomes the approved world council resolution of CCLP Worldwide and Chairman directs the secretariat to intimate the same to successful applicant.

Applicants is admitted as official representative of the organization with defined rank

Removal

An Ambassador may be removed from the Register of Ambassadors by decision of the World Council duly ratified at International Council.

Expulsion

If in the opinion of the World Council an Ambassador prejudices the interests of the Organization through his or her action or inaction, that Ambassador may be expelled from the Organization by decision of the World Council. Before such decision is taken, the Ambassador must be afforded an opportunity by the World Council to reply to the charges either at a hearing
